Resident Professional Liability Insurance Policy

December 2008

Professional liability insurance for residents in UB-sponsored training programs is provided by UB's affiliated hospitals for only those activities that are required by the residency program.

Professional liability coverage includes legal defense and protection against awards from claims reported or filed after the completion of the program(s) if the alleged acts or omissions of the residents are within the scope of the program(s).

There is **NO** coverage for professional activities outside the scope of the residency program for any activity that is not an approved component of the training program, or for moonlighting, under any circumstances. Questions about the scope of professional liability coverage should be directed to the Director, GME Resource Management in the UB Office of Graduate Medical Education (829-6128).

Residents who engage in employment outside their training program ("moonlighting") are responsible for purchasing and maintaining their own professional liability insurance for these activities. The resident is required to provide evidence of the professional liability insurance coverage to their Program Director.
