The UB School of Medicine and Biomedical Sciences offers a one-year, 24-credit Advanced Graduate Certificate Training Program in medical/health informatics. Program participants include health-sciences students and health-care professionals, as well as allied professionals, such as those with backgrounds in computer science, engineering, library and information science, management, and other disciplines.

Holders of the certificate are prepared to lead, design and manage the introduction of effective electronic health-record systems and other health-information systems and tools.
